# **HOT SPRINGS OGDEN**

The Hot Springs of Weber County There are eleven ski resorts along the Wasatch Front, and Utah is known for its skiing. However, recreational skiing didn't appear in Utah until around 1912. Before we had "The Greatest Snow on Earth" attracting locals and tourists, it was the hot springs that drew people in. Hot springs are pools of water that have traveled deep into the Earth, become heated, and returned to the surface. They are often rich in minerals and are believed to have therapeutic and physical health benefits. In the 19th and early 20th centuries, people frequently traveled to hot springs specifically for health purposes. The Wasatch Range offers a unique combination of geological features ideal for the formation of these springs. When Mormon pioneers first arrived in the Salt Lake Valley, one of their first improvement projects in 1848 was the construction of a bathhouse at Warm Springs, located

the northern edge of Salt Lake City. Warm Springs, a geothermal spring along the Wasatch Fault, had been used by the Ute and Shoshone peoples long before the Mormons arrived. Brigham Young envisioned the springs as a community gathering place. However, Ogden has its own hot spring legacy. A legacy that is arguably more iconic than Salt Lake City's. Ogden Canyon Hot Springs At the mouth of Ogden Canyon lies the former site of the Ogden Canvon Sanitarium Resort. Locals are likely familiar with the springs there, located just south of the road and still in use today, albeit not always legally.

Construction of the Ogden Canyon Sanitarium began in 1895. It



offered bathers a hotel, dining room, and dance hall before it burned down in 1927. In 1928, the property changed hands and was renamed "El Monte Springs." A 100,000-gallon swimming pool was added, and the site hosted dance marathons—events in which couples danced for as long as they could to win prizes. The Great Depression of the 1930s forced the closure of this incarnation, but in 1942, Ogden's Mayor Harman W. Peery purchased the property. In 1946, he gifted it to his daughter Rosanne and her husband, Robert King. They restored the spa and renamed it "Rainbow Gardens." The new facility featured both indoor and outdoor swimming pools, as well as a

Over time, hot springs fell out of favor, and Rainbow Gardens eventually transitioned into a retail space. Still, many longtime Ogden residents fondly remember swimming in its pools during the mid-20th century. Pleasant View Hot Springs Further north, where Weber County meets Box Elder County, lies another former hot springs resort. At the edge of Pleasant View, between Highway 89 and I-15 (where a greenhouse now sits hidden from view) once stood a thriving hot springs resort.

Artifacts found in the area suggest that the springs were frequented by Indigenous peoples long before American settlement. In 1843, the infamous "Pathfinder" John C. Fremont visited the springs on his way to the Great Salt Lake. When Miles Goodyear sold his land to the Mormon pioneers, his claim stretched from Weber Canyon northward to these very springs; testament to their early significance.



By 1878, a railroad passed nearby. On one occasion, a man named Rason H. Slater stopped at the springs, sampled the water, and, after finding it lacked the sulfuric odor common to other springs, believed it had healed his ailments. He purchased the land and water rights for\$400.

Slat er constructed rock holding tanks for bathers and developed the site to include a two-story hotel with a dining room, a large pool, a billiard hall, and a dance floor. Visitors came from across the West, hoping the waters would cure their ailments. This resort on the outskirts of Pleasant View predated both Lava Hot Springs (1905) and even the hot spring turned theme park of Lagoon (1896). The site became more than just a health destination. It included a railroad station, dance pavilion, horse racetrack, and

fruit stands selling local produce

from the orchards of Pleasant

View.

In 1889, Slater sold the hot springs for \$50,000. A dedicated rail line was constructed from Ogden to ferry visitors to the springs. By the early 1890s, trains ran north along Washington Boulevard before turning west at Pleasant View Drive to reach the resort. David Eccles and Thomas Dee, prominent Ogden businessmen, purchased the property in 1901 and sold it seven years later. Ogden's first mayor, Lorin Farr, regularly visited the springs in 1909 to treat health issues. He passed away later that year at age 88 at the hot springs.

By 1912, the resort had accrued a \$5,700 debt and was auctioned off. The new owner, J.D. Martin, pledged to eliminate alcohol and run the springs on moral principles. This moral approach was short-lived though and in 1926, during Prohibition, federal



agents raided the property after a teenager succesfully purchased alcohol on-site. On July 7, 1927, another blow was dealt to the resort when a fire devastated parts of the hotel building. By the time the Ogden Fire Department arrived, much of the wooden structure had burned. The blaze was likely visible throughout the valley, marking the loss of a beloved destination.

Though the resort was reopened under new ownership, it never regained its former popularity. In 1947, new regulations required public pools to be chlorinated, an expense that proved too great for the struggling resort.

However, despite declining popularity, the hot springs continued to attract locals. But in the mid-1960s, construction of I-15 cut through part of the resort and by 1970, the land was sold to an explosives company. Many longtime residents still remember soaking in the springs at Pleasant View or Ogden Canyon. Although largely forgotten today, these springs left a lasting impression on the region long before skiing became Utah's main attraction.

Today, both hot springs are closed to the public. The same principle of land ownership that once led to the creation of grand bathhouses now keeps them fenced off. The Pleasant View springs, still visible on cool days by their rising steam, are used in greenhouses. The Ogden Canyon springs, while technically off-limits, are occasionally frequented by locals seeking their therapeutic benefits.

# Wildlife Rehabilitation Center of Northern Utah

### **Receives Community Support for New Loacation**

If you encounter migratory birds and small mammals in places they should not be, or they are injured and clearly need help, Ogden has a rehabilitation center you can take them to. The Wildlife Rehabilitation Center of Northern Utah (WRCNU) is a great wildlife resource we have in Ogden where we can take these mislocated, injured animals to get the treatment they need.

**WRCNU** is one of the few centers in Utah licensed to rehabilitate wildlife. When DaLyn Marthaler was a young girl, she would take in wildlife and care for them as much as possible. This was before it was illegal for the public to take in wild animals. Now, wildlife rehabilitation requires licensing to do so. As she got older, Marthaler expanded her knowledge of rehabilitation by first teaching behavior modification to owners, then working at a conservation education center before becoming the Director of Raptor Care.

WRCNU opened in 2010 in its previous location by Dinosaur Park. The first thing one should do when they find a wild animal is to look at WRCNU's website under

resources for wildlife. There, you can find several links to flowcharts for specific animals, guiding you toward the appropriate solution without necessarily needing to speak to a rehabilitation specialist. Additionally, there is a step-by-step guide on what to do with the animal until you can get help. The catch is that skunks and raccoons, due to rabies and other transmittable diseases/parasites, cannot be sent to a rehabilitation center. WRCNU's website states that, "To 'test' an animal for rabies, they must be killed first, so when you intervene in the life of a perfectly healthy baby raccoon (or skunk, or other mammal) you are opening the door for it to be killed in order to be tested." They advise that unless the animal is acting abnormally or erratically, leave it alone so it has a chance to live a normal life.

In 2023, WRCNU was displaced from their previous location near Dinosaur Park so that the park could expand its parking space. As of today, WRCNU is at what they call a "transition facility," meaning they only plan to be there until their permanent center is built and opened. Buz Marthaler, DaLyn's spouse, said, "We spent almost \$60,000 on paint, fixing walls, new flooring, ceiling work, insulation,

replacing old plumbing fixtures, and repairing leaking pipes, upgrading to new energy-efficient lighting, etc." All that money, simply to operate in a temporary facility, causes great strain for an organization that is operating only for the love and compassion they have for wildlife. While WRCNU does not have a final idea on how much it will cost to build this final dream rehabilitation center, they are currently working with Place Collaborative, an architect firm in Park City, to draw up facility plans. This would give WŔĊNU a better idea of the cost it would take to build the facility and give potential or interested donors a visualization of this center. WRCNU's primary goal is to get the new facility built. Because they are still at their transitional facility, they are limited on how they can help wildlife and the public until they can open their "forever facility." They would love to have a hospital and education center as part of their new facility. They do not need volunteers at this time. and as the summer is their busiest time of year, they usually do not have many events planned. Programs and events are usually saved for the fall



When asked if there is anything WRCNU would like Ogden to know, Buz Marthaler stated, "We are BACK! We are OPEN! We are still here ONLY because of the amazing support YOU have given us. We need your support now more than ever! Over the last couple months, a single Bald Eagle patient has cost us over \$6,000 just in veterinarian bills, not to mention food and housing. We have the cost of treating our patients as well as the need to raise money for the future costs of building our new facility." # **HISTORIC 25th STREET UNION WALK PROJECT**





#### Rising from the Rubble: Union Walk and the Evolution of Historic 25th Street

In the heart of Historic 25th Street—where bricks hold stories, and every façade whispers echoes of Ogden's past—a new shape is rising: Union Walk. It's not just a building; it's a symbol. Of ambition. Of tension. Of what it means to build anew in sacred ground.

Union Walk, a five-story, 55-unit mixed-use development at 144 Historic 25th Street, stands at the crossroads of heritage and progress. Designed by AE Urbia, and spearheaded by Summa Terra Ventures, this building occupies a narrow but mighty footprint: three lots once home to modest structures and bigger dreams.

But before we could raise our eyes to its silhouette, we had to watch it fall.

#### A Beautiful Wreck: The Collapse of Version One

In 2023, the skeleton of Union Walk had begun to take shape—wood framing visible above the skyline, new life being etched into the bones of Ogden's oldest corridor. But inspectors noticed what the eye alone could not:

Improper, untreated lumber exposed to elements.

Sagging joists and leaning trusses—structural misalignments that couldn't be ignored.

Fire code violations that stopped the project

On October 2, 2023, Ogden City declared the structure unsafe. What followed was something rare and painful: full demolition. The development team parted ways with their contractor, Makers Line, and filed a \$9.7 million lawsuit, alleging severe construction mismanagement.

It was a reset few saw coming—and a reminder that even the most well-planned projects can crumble without integrity at the core.

A Second Act Begins
By fall 2024, permits had been reapproved. New contractors stepped in. The blueprint remained the same: five stories of red brick, apartments above, retail below. A nod to the street's historic spirit—but told in a new architectural dialect.

When complete, Union Walk will add 55 apartments to a stretch of downtown hungry for housing. Its retail spaces promise to extend the energy of the street's thriving scene—from restaurants and tattoo parlors to bookshops and jazz lounges.

This is not just about units—it's about density. Walkability. Proximity to transit. It's a cornerstone of the city's "Make Ogden" master plan—a vision that's less about preserving the past in amber, and more about living with it in motion.

#### But Not Without Controversy


Neighbors and preservationists weren't all thrilled. At five stories, Union Walk looms above nearby two- and three-story buildings. Critics say it risks overshadowing the very history it claims to respect.

"It's a beautiful idea—just too tall," said one longtime business owner. "I love growth. But this is Historic 25th Street, not Manhattan."

Still, others argue that 25th Street must evolve to survive. Without new housing, without fresh economic energy, it risks becoming a museum instead of a marketplace.

#### Architectural Balancing Act

Visually, Union Walk is aiming for harmony.



The design includes a red-brick façade, vertical window bays, and restrained ornamentation-more modern infill than faux-Victorian pastiche.

It's a tough gig: honoring texture and proportion while creating something economically viable. In truth, there's no formula. Just intention. Care. And, as we've learned—plenty of oversight.

#### The Soul of the Street

Union Walk is built atop land that has seen brothels, bar fights, and breakthroughs. Its rise comes with a question: how do we honor ghosts while housing the living?

If successful, this project could act as a bridge—connecting young professionals to legacy businesses, tourists to transit, and newcomers to the soul of Ogden. If it falters, it becomes a cautionary tale.

For now, it stands half-built, again. Reborn in the scaffolding of resolve.

#### A City in Motion

As the sun rises this summer over 25th Street, one thing is clear: Ogden is not frozen in time. She breathes. She sheds skin. She remembers. And when Union Walk finally opens its doors, it won't just be about what was built—it'll be about how we chose to move forward while never forgetting where we began.



### The Man Behind the Name: Marshall N. White

Born in 1909 in Humboldt, Tennessee, Marshall N. White's journey was one of perseverance and dedication. After moving to Chicago, he pursued a medical degree, graduating from the Chicago Northwestern Institute of Surgical Podiatry in 1939. His commitment to service led him to the military during World War II, where he served in various capacities, including at the military station hospital in Kearns, Utah.

Settling in Ogden, White became deeply involved in public health and law enforcement. In 1949, he joined the Ogden Police Department, eventually rising to the rank of detective sergeant. His tenure was marked by advocacy for marginalized communities, particularly in Ogden's west side, and he served as president of the local NAACP chapter.

Tragically, on October 16, 1963, while attempting to apprehend a juvenile escapee, White was shot and succumbed to his injuries three days later. His death marked the first time a Black police officer in Utah

was killed in the line of duty. In honor of his service and sacrifice, the Marshall N. White Center was established in 1968, becoming the first city-owned building in Utah named after a person of color.

A Center Reimagined: The New Marshall N. White Center

After more than five decades of serving the community, the original center faced structural challenges, leading to its closure and eventual demolition in 2023. However, the community's unwavering support ensured that the new center would rise on the same historic site.

On May 22, 2025, the ribbon-cutting ceremony marked the beginning of a new chapter. The 68,000-square-foot facility boasts modern amenities, including a pool, indoor track, gymnasium, classrooms, and a kitchen. Vibrant murals celebrating Officer White's legacy adorn the walls, serving as daily reminders of his contributions.

Baltimore artist LaToya Peoples was commissioned to create four expansive murals, each measuring eight feet wide by 26 feet tall. Her work captures the essence of White's life and the community he served, ensuring that visitors, especially the youth, see themselves reflected in the center's narrative.

**Voices of the Community** 

Ron White, Marshall White's son, addressed attendees at the opening ceremony, urging the community to utilize the center as a place of growth and resilience. "Use this place to build strength, build muscle, build endurance because you're going to need it. Life is hard. You'll need the strength to carry you through," he remarked. Mayor Ben Nadolski emphasized the center's role as a cornerstone for the neighborhood, stating, "This has always been an anchor to this neighborhood in particular, and it remains that way."

**A Legacy Continues** 

The reopening of the Marshall N. White Center is more than just a new building; it's a reaffirmation of a community's commitment to inclusivity, remembrance, and progress. As Ogden moves forward, the center stands as a beacon, illuminating the path paved by a man whose life was dedicated to service, equality, and the betterment of his community.










# OGDEN HOLE CELEBRATION 200 YEAR CELEBRATION

Before it was known as the Ogden Valley, the Shoshone knew it to be Ink-ah-wein-da, which translates to "Red Pass Basin." But on May 16, 1825, Peter Skene Ogden, a British trapper and explorer, entered the valley with his Hudson Bay Company and mapped out what we now know as Ogden Valley. Even before Ogden Valley, it was simply known as Ogden Hole. At the time of Ogden's discovery, they were trapping beaver while competing with an American company.

Ogden set up camp at Mountain Green, and the American trappers set up nearby the next day. Both parties were willing to fight for territorial rights, and tensions grew because of it. The Americans claimed the territory was American, and Ogden countered by claiming it was a joint control territory or the British and American governments.

When Ogden naturally refused to give up the territory, the American company, specifically deserters who had joined the American company a year prior, went to Ogden's underpaid men and offered them \$3.50 per beaver and cheaper goods. A great many men deserted. According to Utah's History to Go website, "John Grey, an Iroquois trapper, told Ogden, 'You have dealt fair with me and with all of us. But go we will.... If every man in the camp does not leave

you, they seek not their own interest." These men took with them their supplies and horses. With less men, supplies, and horses, Ogden disbanded and returned to the Ogden Valley on May 25. The area of this territorial fight in Mountain Green is now known as Deserter Point. The History to Go website mentions the irony of both Ogden and the American company trying to claim the area as part of their territory when "...neither party had a territorial claim to the land. Under the Adams-Onis Treaty Mountain Green was part of Mexican territory in 1825."

Now, 200 years later, Ogden celebrated this momentous discovery with several events, all of which are highlighted below. As a nod to their ancestor, descendants of Ogden dressed up as mountain men and fired off their muzzleloaders to mark the beginning of the Ogden Marathon on May 17. The Ogden Marathon has been a treasured tradition since 2001. On May 21st, in Eden at the Hearthside venue, there was a historical lecture by renowned historian and BYU professor Jay Buckley. He spoke about the impact of Peter Skene Ogden's expedition on the valley's development. The lecture by Jay Buckley is the ninth annual lecture in a series titled "In Search of Ogden Hole." It is always free to attend.

Four new historic markers were dedicated to commemorating Ogden's various camping sites. Additionally, there was a

celebration for the descendants of Ogden where they were included in a special registry. They were given certificates to recognize their lineage. This evening event was full of readings of Ogden's journals, and Fort Buenaventura's Mountain Man Association dressed in their full mountain man regalia to bring a visual representation of what the men looked like to the event and to honor the mountain men who settled the valley.

Finally, there was a historic reenactment at Deserters Point in Mountain Green. It was performed off of I-80, at the west-bound rest stop. The rest stop already houses a statue of Ogden, accompanied by a plaque detailing "The only hostile encounter between American and British furtrappers..." This reenactment also offered a chance for locals and tourists alike a chance to meet the descendants of Ogden.


























# ONSTAGE OGDEN SEASON 2025 IMPRESSES

Ogden has a rich and diverse history of music, largely thanks to our railroad culture and historic 25th Street. From jazz saxophonist Joe McQueen who arrived in Ogden in 1945 and stayed until his passing in 2019, to the Ogden culture of supporting indie bands and emerging artists of all kinds, we are indeed lucky to have such a great music scene in our beautiful city. We have many integral venues here that support live music, such as Funk 'n Dive, Brewskis, Kamikazes, Ogden Twilight, Red Light Bar, Black Lung Society, and more. Another amazing organization that brings music to Ogden culture is Onstage Ogden. It is located at 638 26th Street, and it is committed to bringing talented musicians to Ogden for us to enjoy as a community.

Onstage Ogden began in 1949 when Beverly Lund and Ginny Matthei, two local Ogden women, decided they wanted to bring more culture to the city. They organized and fundraised a concert by The Utah Symphony at Ogden High School. According to the Onstage Ogden website, "The total cost was \$400, and three hundred people attended the concert." The success of this concert made the women want to continue to bring music to Ogden. The name of the organization may have changed several times, but that did not prevent the group from eventually adding Ballet West performances in the late 70's.

It was only in 2019 that this organization changed its name to Onstage Ogden. The current Executive Director of Onstage Ogden, James Fredrick, told Street Ogden Magazine that they are just wrapping up their











75th anniversary season. When asked about the organization's current goals, he stated, "The North Star for us is really continuing to grow our audience and bring more folks to shows. At a more 30,000 level, we want our performances to be a part of Ogden's civic ecosystem, elevating the quality of life here." With each year, Onstage Ogden tries to bring more performances to the city. For the 2025/2026 season, there are 31 performances, the most they have ever had before. Performances are presented across four venues: Peery's Egyptian Theater, The Monarch, the Ogden Amphitheater, and Weber State University's Browning Center.

Personally, Mr. Fredrick is excited about several upcoming performances. He said, "It is hard to just pick a few, but I will try. The new big thing for us this year is the Summer Concert Series at the Ogden Amphitheater which will include four shows from June through September. I'm really looking forward to The Wailin' Jennys on September 13th." He also stated that their concerts at The Monarch are always a great time, adding that "...we set them up with a casual vibe couches, cocktails, tables, a full bar, and a food truck." There will be five concerts at The Monarch next year.

James Fredrick would love to see more faces at each and every performance, so be sure to grab tickets to a show or two. # **VORRARO** \* Band of Many Voices

Ogden's music scene is vibrantly alive—pulsing with fresh energy and seasoned evolution, always creating something original in our valley. New talents emerge. Longtime favorites reshape themselves, fusing hardwon experience with fearless experimentation. It's not just about playing the hits—it's about daring to evolve.

While familiar sounds comfort and connect, true artistry stretches into the unknown, inviting us into uncharted sonic territory.

That's where Vorraro comes in.

A new band made up of four veteran musicians, Vorraro is the product of over 160 combined years in professional music—both in bands and solo ventures, most of them rooted right here in Ogden. That's an average of 40 years apiece. Together, these men have forged something raw, brave, and refreshingly original. A band of many voices. Many eras. Many styles. All coming together to create the singular sound of VORRARO.

At its center is Daniel Weldon—a soul-searching songwriter whose clarity of vision and emotional range ground the band. With decades of experience and a natural instinct for collaboration, Daniel draws his bandmates into a sound that is at once intimate and expansive.

Alongside him is the masterful Ryan Hawthorn, whose guitar and slide work add depth, tension, and texture to every track.

Their combined experience isn't just a resume—it's a legacy. Daniel has played solo acoustic sets for decades, maintaining ongoing weekly gigs in Park City for over ten years. In the early 2000s, he held court at the Wine Cellar on Washington Blvd—before it became Funk 'n Dive—when it was still known as "a jazzy place." He's also played in notable local acts like the Legendary Porch Pounders, Bastard Redheads, and numerous collaborative projects.

Ryan has graced Ogden stages for nearly thirty years. I first saw him in the Weber

River Blues Band, and later in AJ which I got to know well playing at Mojos for years and often, and also Johnny Utahs and Pinetop Inferno also had a fiery run in the local scene.

Jeff Aaron, the bassist, has been performing in Ogden since the early 2000s—playing alongside Ryan in Johnnys Utahs among others as in noteable ska band Hoo Ray Who.

Drummer Martin Carle, originally stationed at Hill Air Force Base, became a permanent part of the scene. He plays the drums like they're an extension of his soul—fluid, fierce, and fully present.

I was lucky enough to catch Vorraro live at Side Bar recently, as they opened the Summer Concert Series in the Backyard amphitheater. The setting was cinematic—original music ringing out against a mountain backdrop as the sun dipped into dusk and dragonflies danced like spirits through the spring air. They've also played a string of shows at Brewskis and have more lined up, with plans to perform at local venues monthly, possibly open for touring acts in Salt Lake City, and, of course, return to Park City.

Vorraro is a labor of love—but it's also serious business. I got a personal taste of that in their rehearsal and recording studio at the Old Post Office building on 24th & Grant. I sat in the center of the room, surrounded by amps and backed by drums—like being hotboxed inside a musical fantasy. I told them I felt like I was inside the speakers themselves.

Their studio is a whole experience. You walk through marble hallways, take a vintage lift elevator, and step into a high-ceilinged room facing Mount Ben Lomond, framed by old wood trim and windows that whisper stories from a time when buildings had soul.

They played two songs just for me. I swear those songs entered me—deep, emotional, echoing through my bones. Each one had its own voice, its own story. Some personal to Daniel's own life. Others inspired by those around him, as he channels the lived stories of others into song.

And then, there's the name: Vorraro, It rolls

off the tongue like the name of a hillside Italian village—music echoing from wine groves, families shouting across dinner tables over plates of pasta and bottles of local red vino, made from Nonna's century-old recipe. It emits tone. Flavor. Heat. Color.

As it turns out, the name has roots as real as the stories in their songs. You'll have to ask Daniel to tell you the full tale (it's worth hearing), but let's just say a DNA test revealed surprising Italian heritage. Once Daniel shared the spicy story with the band, it was Ryan who suggested that's the name. Since then, Daniel has embraced his Italian roots alongside his Weldon name—and it shows in the music.


I got to hear much of their material live and at rehearsal. I even walked away with a CD I've been playing nonstop as I write this. Each track holds a personality. A pulse. A story. They take you on a journey of sound and soul. One song in particular—"Love Sick Heart"—hit me deep when I heard it live at Side Bar. It crept in with a somber swirl and ended in quiet triumph. It had that moody, psychedelic pulse like a Pink Floyd groove—familiar, but entirely its own.

Vorraro has 28 original songs in just over a year together—enough for a three-hour show. All original. All unique.

And here's what makes them different: this is a true collaboration. Daniel often writes the skeleton of a song—lyrics, basic chords—and sends it to the band. Each member then adds their own layer, their own flavor, in full. Then they come together and stir the sauce. It's a team effort from first note to final mix.

Like Nonna's sauce, it's the blend of many voices, many ingredients, that makes it unique, flavorful and most of all...magic.
